1. The first Sunday in every month is the Family Service in Church at 9.45am. Everyone is very welcome.
2. There is a Little Ones service on the first Tuesday of each month. It's a short service with a story, prayer and live music followed by refreshments. It's at 11.00am in church
3. Once again we will be supporting Love in a Box. Later in the term we will be collecting shoe boxes to send to Eastern Europe via Mustard Seed Relief Mission. We sent out lots of boxes last year and hope to do the same again this year!
4. We hope the children will join the adult members of the church for the last part of the service. It reminds us that we are one family. The children always enjoy showing their work and everyone enjoys seeing it. If you wish to take your child home after Assembly but find that we have already gone over to church, be assured that your child will be safe in church with their group leader.
5. At the moment we have not got contact details for all children at Sunday's School. It is important for us to have this information. If this is the case for your child, your group leader will be asking you to complete some forms. We would also like to have email addresses for everyone.
