Rubbings are such good fun and so easy to do. We are surrounded by hundreds of different textures. Once you start looking, you'll find loads!


You can make rubbings from leaves, flower heads, tree trunks, brickwork, paths, fencing, coins, radiators, buttons, fabric, trainer soles, Weetabix......just about anything!

Take some plain A4 paper and some wax crayons. (They are best but you can use pencil crayons if you use them lightly without too much pressure).

To make an interesting picture you can rotate your paper so you get the rubbing from a different angle..... or make a tessellated picture.....or layer your rubbings on top of each other for effect.



When you're happy with your masterpiece, you can always add a colour wash of diluted paint for a wax resist effect.

You can all do rubbings and then ask the other members of your family to guess what yours are. To make it harder, only do a part of the object eg. a part of a leaf
