Kids love making up plays and what better way than with easy to make puppets.

Use one of those many socks that's lost its partner in the washing machine!

Add wool or string for hair; use googly eyes or cut out eyes from fabric or card and glue on.

Stripy socks make great zebras and orange socks make fabulous long-necked giraffes! You can draw a pattern on the sock with felt tips for the giraffe's special markings.

If your children want, they can cut the front off a large carboard box and make a theatre. Paint the theatre to make it look good and how about adding curtains?

You could make a set of puppets to go with your favourite story book and then retell the story.
